Report to the Board July 19, 2002

Accomplishments since Spring, 2002

- 1. The AAUW NC web site look and feel was upgraded
 - Consistent navigation buttons on all new pages
 - Banners for branches on the state home page.
 - Lists of relevant links on the left of all pages.
- 2. Automated collection of branch officer information and distribution of officer counterpart information.
- 3. Supported the start of the AAUW NC Online Satellite with Winston-Salem as the host branch.
- 4. Survey on AAUW NC e-mail list showed good acceptance by the board. Members less connected to the state organization were less well served by the list.
- 5. Continued tech consulting to NC Women United. They are still borrowing web space from AAUW NC.
- 6. Began analysis of discrepancies in the spring and summer Tar Heel News mailing lists. As a side effect, found a list of 15 members in 10 branches with "bad addresses" and forwarded those to branch contacts for resolution.
- 7. Completed draft job description see attached.

Plans (by Fall Board meeting)

- 1. Prepare a more general policy on electronic communication (balancing privacy and visibility) for the board's approval. (Volunteers to review this would be appreciated. Please contact Laura or me.)
- 2. Encourage all AAUW NC board members with programmatic responsibilities to contribute summary information for the web site.
- 3. Implement "digest" option for those who would prefer collections of e-mail messages related to AAUW NC.
- 4. Create a flyer that works as an introduction to the web site -- for the AAUW NC 2003 Convention.

Deferred (need does not appear critical)

- 1. Discuss registration of www.aauwnc.org (budget impact of \$70 for two years).
- 2. List of technology camps on the web site.
