September 19, 2003

***Accomplishments since Summer, 2003***

1. Turned over the AAUW NC branch/state officer database to Joanne Hill.
2. Continued tech consulting to NC Women United.
3. Worked with the Treasurer to implement an online form for MALs to join AAUW NC. Payment is by check or with Paypal.
4. Registered the domain name [aauwnc.org](http://aauwnc.org). This offers the following benefits:
  - Our web address is now [www.aauwnc.org](http://www.aauwnc.org) (in addition to [www.rtpnet.org/aauwnc](http://www.rtpnet.org/aauwnc)). It will not need to change if we move the site from RTPnet.
  - We can set up an unlimited number of e-mail addresses for the officers and committees. While these have fewer options than the "lists" that we are using ([aauwnc-list@rtpnet.org](mailto:aauwnc-list@rtpnet.org), [aauwnc-rcc@rtpnet.org](mailto:aauwnc-rcc@rtpnet.org)), they allow for addresses like "president@aauwnc.org" that can be "permanent" across officer changes and can have more than one person "monitoring" e-mail.
  - We can set up an unlimited number of subdomains, e.g. "rwc.aauwnc.org" for the Raleigh/Wake County web site and "members.aauwnc.org" pointing to the "Members Only" section of the web site.
5. Documented all account passwords and forwarded to AAUW NC Treasurer and Secretary.

***Plans (by Spring Board meeting)***

1. Process for handling ongoing updates to the AAUW NC branch and state officer contact information and getting that information available on the web still needs to be implemented.
2. Work with Marty to implement a "communications community" for support of branch newsletter/web/public information officers.
3. Continue to discuss the future of the web site with the advisory committee.
