July 23 2004

Notes since Spring 2004

1. The 04-05 state/branch officer directory has had pretty good compliance with 19 of the 22 branches reporting changes to their boards. There seemed to be a technical problem with Gaston Regional, and I haven't heard anything from Franklin County or Bryson City. Counterparts lists are being distributed to the board members at this meeting giving the new contacts, and updates will be at <http://members.aaunc.org>.
2. We did use the online form for AAUW NC at-large membership to handle the dues for a Raleigh/Wake County member who was converting from MOB to MAL status. I haven't had information from Millie that the dues have been posted to the AAUW NC account and exactly what fee was charged by PayPal.
3. I served as a judge in the AAUW TX web site evaluation leading up to their convention. Their criteria was an interesting checklist for any branches who may be considering web sites.
4. I've been consulting with the Younger Members Caucus on their electronic communication needs. Their Yahoo! List is up and running. The Women of Color caucus collected \$150 to support its own web site, but current information is that since they don't have a long range plan, that money is being returned. This may be a discussion at the 2005 convention.
5. My work with NC Women United led to a test of the web conferencing software that we'll be using at that meeting. On July 1, I started a two-year term as their secretary.
6. I've got the best of intentions to get with Marty and use the "Communications" counterparts list (see #1) to provide better support for the branches.
